When will Coll Bunkhouse reopen and what can I expect?

We reopened to UK travellers on the 26 April but some areas of the UK are not permitted to travel here due to localised Covid measures. Customers are still required to wear a face covering (unless medically exempt) when moving around the shared spaces.

Check in times – It's vital that we protect our staff as well as customers. We ask you to come to An Cridhe as soon as you arrive on Coll, but please be aware you will not be able to access your room until it has been cleaned and prepared for you. If you are staying more than one night, we will not clean your room during your stay but will ensure bins are emptied, and you can contact us if you do have cleaning needs that can't be managed with the items provided.

How has Covid affected Coll Bunkhouse?

Shared living/kitchen/dining space - this space is available now for shared use and social distancing is no longer required. Please use considerately, and make use of the hand sanitiser on entry. The public laundry does not have 'hang to dry' facilities just now. There is an outdoor line and some portable drying racks which can be placed outside the Bunkhouse to dry items.

Our changes for your comfort and safety

For now, we are not operating like a traditional hostel, but we hope you'll find our changes great for couples/families/households.

Fraoch (Heather): sleeps 3 in a single over double bunk bed Bliochan (Bog Asphodel): sleeps 5, 1x single over double, 1 x single over single

Sobhrach (Primrose):

sleeps 5, 1 x single over double, 1 x single over single

All rooms:

- Dedicated toilet / shower per room at least one of each
- Microwave, toaster, kettle, mini fridge
- Folding dining table with chairs
- Ample storage room for your items

When traditional hostelling returns we will still be a hostel, but we love the look of our newly designed rooms and we will certainly be keeping some of the changes.
